Voices - 2

Our head is filled with voices day by day

Originally spoken by someone telling us what we would

amount to or what we should or shouldn't do with our lives

Maybe telling us that we would never amount to anything

or that we would only be valuable if we did this or that

– you get the picture

Through out the course of an average day we are bombarded with 50,000 - 70,000 thoughts That's 35 to 48 thoughts per minute per person

Research shows that as many as 70% - 80% of those thoughts are negative

There is a word for this kind of "self talk"

Logorrhea meaning

- 1. Pathologically incoherent, repetitious speech.
- 2. Incessant or compulsive talkativeness; wearisome volubility

Most of us think that God never speaks to us, but the truth is God is always speaking, always directing, always protecting, warning, correcting and affirming

The Spirit of God will speak to us with promptings that may not be audible yet in perfect harmony with the scripture

Romans 8:26-27

26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered . 27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God. NKJV

God has given us the ability to choose the dialogue we believe and respond to We can learn to hear the whisper of Gods voice

Psalm 131:2

2 Surely I have calmed and quieted my soul; like a weaned child with his mother, like a weaned child is my soul within me [ceased from fretting]. AMP

There's more at stake then just thinking happy thoughts or being a more cheerful person or improving your lot in life

What's at stake are great deeds that remain undone

"Great deeds remain undone and the possibility of growth into greatness of soul is aborted" – Brennan Manning, Abba's Child: The Cry of the Heart for Intimate Belonging

Daniel 11:32 vision of the latter days

32 Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits. NKJV

What great deeds remain undone because of the lies that were planted in your past or fears of the uncertainty of the future?

What sense of purpose in your heart remains unfulfilled?

What weeds are growing where there were once God inspired ideas?

How many contributions remain no more than good intentions because of spiritual hesitation?

What good deeds are in your future that require you to confront these lies right now?

If these lies are not quieted what will come of the calling that God has placed on your life?

How many relationships are being negatively impacted in your life because you have chosen to believe these lies?

2 Timothy 1:6

Galatians 4:9

9 But now after you have known God, or rather are known by God, how is it that you turn again to the weak and beggarly elements, to which you desire again to be in bondage? NKJV

- God is trying to communicate with us on a level that is not of this world
- The clutter and chaos in our minds makes it hard for
 His signal to get through think in the right language

Stop wishing God would take away the struggles we face for it's in those struggles we overcome the clutter God wants us to learn to trust His plan not our pain

Philippians 3:8

8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ. NKJV

In his book *The War of Art*, Steven Pressfield writes about overcoming the battles that block creativity

We feel like hell. A low grade misery pervades everything. Were bored, were restless. We can't get no satisfaction. There's guilt but we can't put our finger on the source. We want to go back to bed; we want to get up and party. We feel unloved and unlovable. We're disgusted. We hate our lives. We hate ourselves.

This is where the enemy wants to keep us – confused forever questioning God and our purpose

Isaiah 61:7 NKJV

7 Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, And instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion.

Everything that has ever existed started with a word spoken by God – call and response – Isaiah 46:10

Genesis 1:3 NKJV

3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Here we see the cadence of communication that declares the creative potential of the voice of God in our lives

The enemy questions and tempts us

Genesis 3:1b

And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" NKJV

God's voice speaks with precision and power, inviting us into a way of life that is truly life

Opposing voices seek to draw us out of His presence through seduction and deception Even self-deception

- James 1:22-24; Psalm 36:2, 3, 1 John 1:8 NKJV

Genesis 3:11

11 And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" NKJV

John 10:27

27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. NKJV

Philippians 3:9 NKJV

9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;

We must believe that we have a new identity and that we hear His voice

We must remove the clutter and distraction so we are able to discern His voice clearly and live in the power of His resurrection

"When it comes to hearing God's voice, identity always comes before activity." – Steven Furtick

Isaiah 55:3 NKJV

3 Incline your ear, and come to Me.

Take your thoughts captive

Speak life into your situation – with authority – John 6:63

Endure temptation – resist deception

Receive the good things God has for your life by embracing the truth of His voice!

2 Corinthians 10:5

5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ. NKJV

4 things we must remember to quiet the clutter

God says I am – Overpower the *Voice* of your insecurities

God says He will – Overpower the *Voice* of your fears

God says He has – Overpower the *Voice* of condemnation

God says I can – Overpower the *Voice* of discouragement

The voice we choose to believe will determine our future

Most of us go through life hoping that something will turn out right

- o Maybe we'll hit the lottery
- Someone will finally pick us for their team and rescue us from this self-inflicted prison

We all need people around us to affirm us, build us up or encourage us but the verbal clutter in our minds take a perfectly good desire and distorts it beyond recognition

So we spend our lives hoping to be good enough, justified or vindicated!

This makes it hard to hear the voice of God which does all of those things for us when we hear Him

Much of the time we have the wrong understanding of what insecurity is

In some ways insecurity is the ultimate insult to God In fact it is rooted in pride

- We feel that somehow God didn't quite get the job done when He made us
- o Or He can't possibly take care of our present situation
- The TRUTH is that all of us struggle with insecurity from time to time

Every one of us needs to know that God chose us not because we get it all right but because He knows us and appointed us You don't have to do a single thing for God or anyone else to notice you

Jeremiah 1:5

5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew [and] approved of you [as My chosen instrument], and before you were born I separated and set you apart, consecrating you; [and] I appointed you as a prophet to the nations. AMP

- o I want you
- o I've chosen you
- You belong to me you always have and always will
- o Before you were born I KNEW YOU!
